## Waterloo Historical Society Senior Executive and Publication Members 1913-present with Notes on the Annual Report's / Volume's Publishing

Names are first printed here just as they appear in the Annual Report / Volume. Subsequently, in these listings ditto marks or initialled short forms are used. Short forms using initials refer to the last previously shown full form of the person's name.

Typically for the time, the title Mr was never used for men's names but for women, the title Miss or Mrs was. They are retained in these lists as an M with the women's initials. Once the title is dropped in the Volumes in the mid-1980s, the woman's full name is rewritten as it appears in the Volume – subsequent short forms reflect the new version.

The Presidents', Vice-Presidents', Secretaries' and Treasurers' names are always shown exactly as in the Reports / Volumes except when ditto-ed. Minor variations are written out fully. Educational degree letters are not included in these listings.

aa The actual month and year of publication are not printed in the first 18 Reports. The Reports are dated on the title page with the year the report covers but the WHS meetings noted therein occurred late in those years so the Reports could not have been published by year's end. Judging by future Reports which *did* note the month and year, they would probably have been released in the early months of the <u>following</u> year. Report 1 lists the WHS Executive Committee. Subsequent Reports until 1984 list WHS Council members and Committee members. See 1985 notes.

- **ab** Contains a listing of all WHS members
- ac WHS itself issued at least three bound Volumes of its Reports: i) Five Report Volume 1: 1913-1917 with errata and index;
- ii) *Five Report Volume II: 1918-1922* with errata and index; iii) *Five Report Volume III: 1923-1927* with index. See **ae** below for further Report Volume news. Volumes I and II, composed of ten slimmer Reports, are combined into one single bound volume.

Volume III, because of five lengthier Reports, is a stand-alone bound volume.

Reports 1 to 5 are paginated beginning with Page 1 in each volume but there is no consistency in determining what is Page 1 – sometimes it is the title page, which may or may not be the first page inside the covers; at other times a different page was chosen to be labeled Page 1. *Actual printed* Page Numbering in the early Reports varies, beginning with 1, 5, 7, 9 or 11.

Reports 6 to 10 are paginated consecutively from Page 1 in Report 6 and continue until Page 270 at end of Report 10. This consecutive numbering, beginning each *set* at Page 1, continues through succeeding sets of five (Reports 11 to 15; 16 to 20; 17 to 25; 26 to 30) even in individually-issued reports after bound Report volumes ceased being produced by WHS. The resulting confusion in these early issues of the WHS Reports continues to cause problems for researchers. Beginning with Report 31 (1943), all subsequent Reports and Volumes start with Page 1 (whether or not the page is actually numbered in print). With one exception (Report 39, 1951) Page 1 is the actual first page inside the covers. Both full-page interior photographs and frontispieces are excluded from pagination until Report 40 (1952). Thereafter full-page photographs are included in the pagination. Frontispiece photographs or maps were included in each issue until Report 24 (1936) and then intermittently until Report 36 (1948) when the final frontispiece appeared.

ad During the Depression, the Annual Report was often delayed. On several occasions, a double issue was published thus the *first* year of each double issue's report was 12 months late: (1931-32, 1933-34, 1935-36 and 1939-40). For the 1935-36 issue, the delay was a full year beyond this. One can only imagine the problems with membership and finances plus the ability to generate enough material to publish (note the slimness of the late 1930s issues) which caused these problems. Strangely, in some of these double-issue years, individual single year issues were also published but both reports have the same publication date – a year late for the earlier report. No double issues for 1937-38 are known: both single issues show July 1939 as publication date.

ae A few copies of a Fourth bound Volume are known. (See earlier ac note and add) iiii) *Five Report Volume Four: 1928-1932 more*. On the title page of Report 20 (1932), the phrase "Completing Volume IV" is printed under the title. Note, however, that several libraries and other institutions did do their own binding of the WHS annual reports. The four bound Volumes described here and in ac (previous page) were WHS productions. Pagination is continuous through Reports 21-25 (1933-37) indicating there was some idea of publishing a Fifth bound Volume. By the time of Report 25 (1937) this idea had evidently been abandoned since "Completing Volume V" does *not* appear on that issue's title page. However, the pagination for Reports 26-30 (1938-1942) is indeed consecutive thus indicating some remaining thought of binding those five into what would have been a Sixth bound Volume. [The use of the word Volume in these instances should not be confused with the later title of the Annual Report – see note for 1957]

**af** No *individual* issues are known of the Annual Reports for 1933 and 1934. They were issued in a 156-page double issue published in May 1935.

ag Beginning with Report 31 (1943) pagination begins anew in each report, usually with the title page being a phantom (un-numbered) Page 1.

**ah** Annual Reports 1 through 31 (1913-1943) print WHS council members' names (including positions not shown in this table) for the calendar year shown on the cover. Beginning with #32, (1944 on the cover) the council members' list printed inside is for the *actual* year of publication, shown *at bottom of the title page*. This was probably caused by the death of WH Breithaupt on January 26, 1944. Had the report continued the previous practice, it would have shown the late WH Breithaupt as a member of both the WHS council and WHS publication committee in an issue that also had a lengthy obituary of him. FWR Dickson stepped into the Museum and Publication Committee that year and it is probable that he made the decision which has since been followed — i.e. list the council [later the board] members for the year of actual publication rather than the just-finished year (= year on the publication's cover.)

ai The years 1947 and 1948 are dated incorrectly on the front cover. Report 35 is shown as 1948 but should be 1947 (there is always a difference of 12 between the report number and the cover year's last two digits (e.g. Report 1 and Year 1913=12). Report 36 is shown as 1949 but should be 1948. The *publishing* date on the title page and the date above the council listing are correct in Report 35. Report 36 has the title page date (June 1949) correct although it mis-dated the *council* listing as 1948, it should be 1949 and it *is* the correct 1949 list of names. The next issue, Report 37 is properly dated 1949. A similar problem occurs in 1965. See ap at that point for explanation.

**aj** In Reports 37 and 38, the *title page's publication* date is printed incorrectly. The cover year was used instead of publication date. By past and subsequent issues, Report 37 should read May or June 1950 and Report 38 should read May or June 1951.

**ak** In Report 41 (1953) there is no title page but on back cover is written:

"PUBLISHED BY THE SOCIETY / MUSEUM, KITCHENER PUBLIC LIBRARY, / KITCHENER, ONTARIO / FEBRUARY 1954."

In Report 42 (1954) there is no title page or publishing information anywhere. Internally, a financial statement dated January 28, 1955 is printed and confirms a publication date beyond that, probably late winter / early spring 1955.

al Beginning with 45 (1957), the cover bore the title Annual Volume instead of Annual Report. FWR Dickson discovered that money could be saved by renaming the society's annual report as the annual volume. It has borne that title ever since. See WHS Centennial Supplement (2012) page 294.

**am** For two years, RS Oberholtzer is listed as Membership Secretary with Mrs M Hall but the position disappeared after that.

**an** The Council listing for 1961 began showing an Archives Committee. It lasted a decade and is detailed, along with other small, shorter-term WHS committees, in **Appendix #1** after these listings.

**ao** Volume 50 features the first colored cover – bright orange. Previous colors were varying shades of neutral grey or brown. It is also the first to exceed 100 pages except for 1927 which includes a number of speeches from the Waterloo County Pioneers' Memorial Tower opening.

ap Volume 53 is mis-labeled on the cover with the publication date, June 1966. It should read simply 1965. See also ar below

**az** Published for the first time in Volume 84 was Patrons, a listing of members and organizations who donated \$100 toward the cost of upgrading the volume's production. Patrons have continued to be listed ever since.

ba Beginning with Volume 85 the list of officers is titled Board of Directors followed by the Councillors and Committees. See note aa 1913.

**bb** Volume 86 was the first to feature a color image (or image of any sort) on the inside back cover.

bc The Board of Directors lists are incorrectly dated 1998 instead of 1999 in Volume 86 and incorrectly 1999 instead of 2000 in Volume 87.

**bd** The back cover of Volume 89 featured an image; in future all back covers would be used for image reproduction. With this Volume the ISSN number changed to 0215-5021. Volume 89 also saw the beginning of the Donations and Acquisitions feature which highlights regional archives, libraries, museums and historic sites. This issue also debuted the WHS Local History Award for a paper by a 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> year UW or WLU student. Several more winning papers have been published in subsequent years.

**bf** Another first: the cover of Volume 93 is a wraparound of an 1877 etching of the Huether Hotel *plus* the back cover is a foldout with other Huether images and some early Oktoberfest items both inside and out. All subsequent Volumes have images on the back cover, inner and outer.

**bg** The 2005 WHS By-Laws are printed at the rear of the volume.

**bh** The front and back covers, inside and out, feature a background image of Carl Ahrens' palette with photos of him on front and on rear inner and outer covers. The first instance of one-theme on all four covers.

**bi** Volume 95 begins listing "Board and Council" under the headings "Officers, Directors and Councillors". Committee rosters are eliminated with only their Chairs noted. The Publication Committee is listed at a separate location following the contents. The back cover is a foldout that features images of Kaufman Rubber Company.

bj Volume 96 featured another foldout back cover using a Westmount subdivision brochure from 1914. It is the final foldout cover used to date.

**bk** Perfect binding and a higher grade of paper were two steps forward as Annual Volume 100 was published. Since Report 39 (1951) the publications had used saddle-stitch binding and the limit had been reached on number of pages allowed by that style. [In earlier days, from 1913 to 1950, glued signatures had been the form of binding.]

**bl** As part of WHS' first 100 years a *Centennial Supplement* was produced and published. It features over two dozen articles reprinted from the first century of publications plus analysis and commentary.

**bm** The first-ever foldout front cover featured a dramatic photo of the Waterloo Region Museum. For the first time also, in-text color photos were featured in two articles. Originally planned as 220 pages, the volume appeared with only 216 due to an error at the bindery. The missing sections will appear in 102.
