**Bus routes:** Downtown Kitchener - from Kitchener City Hall Station, take #4 bus (direction Boardwalk Station) to Glasgow/Dunbar, walk 2 blocks north on Dunbar

Uptown Waterloo - from Waterloo Public Square Station, take #7 bus (direction Fairway Station) to King/Union, then take #4 bus (direction Boardwalk Station) to Glasgow/Dunbar, walk 2 blocks north on Dunbar - or from Waterloo Public Square Station, take #16 bus (direction Conestoga College) to Belmont/Union, walk 3 blocks west on Union
